- You will be asked to form groups of 2 or more students (depending on the number of students taking the course). As a group you will be required to prepare presentation(s) and discussion(s) of research papers.
- 2. You will be asked to individually write a short essay on a topic of your choice (among the ones in a list that will be provided at the beginning of the course) that you will have to hand out the day of the final exam.

Session planning – Planification des séances

The course will consist of two parts. The first part will be devoted to the presentation and discussion of the main topics in behavioral economics. The second part will be devoted to the discussion of the experimental method in economics. A macroeconomic experiment will be presented and discussed in detail.
